

How to Register for an Event


Log into your account

Click on the Events Tab in the Top Menu

Scroll down until you find the event you want to attend

Click on “REGISTER”


A screen similar to this will appear:




Your email address will show up in the Email box

Click “NEXT”

Now you will see a screen similar to this:




If you are bringing someone with you, (guest or member) click ADD GUEST. We will go through that now. If you are not bringing a guest you would click “NEXT”



If you clicked “ADD GUEST” you would see a screen similar to this:


Fill in the First and Last Name of your guest. Email and Phone are not required.

Then click DONE




Now you will see a screen like this:

At this point you can add another guest, delete the guest you added, cancel the entire registration, or click NEXT to complete the registration

Now click “CONFIRM” to complete your registration.

This is your confirmation of your registration. You should also get an email confirmation from the website with all of the details of the event.

Here is a sample confirmation email for this event:
